Seminars, Courses & Presentations

16-17/6/2006 **C-TPAT Compliance Training**

Jointly organized with TaTtc, the C-TPAT workshop aims to help factories in upgrading their skills and knowledge in Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism initiative. The workshop was attended by 20 participants from 10 factories.

6-7/7/2006 **Workshop on Lean Manufacturing**

The workshop provides the technical tools, supporting strategies and concepts that help and guides manufacturers to become lean. Well delivered by Mr. Charles Dagher who is the CEO of Dagler Consulting Group, there were 14 participants from 6 companies.

MITI is seriously considering our request for mandatory labeling on local clothing. We have also proposed to adopt the CEPT rules of origin to determine the country of origin.

On the worn clothing issue, the Royal Customs Malaysia has informed all entry points to be alert and to submit monthly statistical report on the import of worn clothing.

SIRIM Textile Technical & ISCQ Meetings

Mr. Yong Kok Swee represented MKMA to attend and contributed at the SIRIM Textile Technical Meetings on Textile and Chemical Tests and ISCQ Meetings.

The group studied and worked on **Development of Malaysian Standards** covering method of sampling textile fibres for testing, relevant standards on testing of heavy metals and textiles, ISO standard on pesticides, tests for colour fastness etc.
